Dear Friend,

I am writing to invite you to participate in our annual charity Golf Tournament. I hope that you will enter a team to play in this great event. The golfers, including judges, lawyers, and local professionals spend an enjoyable day playing golf and socializing at the dinner. Also please consider sponsoring our tournament. Enclosed is more information about the various sponsor levels available.

Senior Citizens Legal Services (SCLS) hosts this golf tournament every year to support our work providing free legal assistance to low income senior citizens. This year the Tournament will be on Friday, August 25th, 2017 at DeLaveaga Golf Course in Santa Cruz.

Funds raised at this event help SCLS provide free assistance to low-income seniors like "Juana" and her elderly mother "Rosa". Juana and Rosa were facing eviction from their subsidized housing project. Both Juana and Rose were low income individuals and they both suffered from severe disabilities. Due to their disabilities, both clients were approved for extensive in-home supportive services hours and Juana's brother, "Jose" was their approved IHSS caregiver. They were served with an eviction notice based on an incorrect belief that Jose was living in their home. SCLS requested a reasonable accommodation to allow them to stay in their home with Jose as their live-in aide. SCLS provided the housing provider with evidence of Rosa and Juana's disabilities and documentation showing that Jose had continuously maintained a separate residence. However, the housing provider refused the reasonable accommodation. Eventually, the housing provider agreed to allow a reasonable accommodation for a live-in caregiver and associated waiver of the notice but only if Juana and Rosa chose a live-in caregiver other than Jose. Juana and Rosa were forced to turn down the alternative accommodation as there was simply no one else available to provide them with overnight care.

SCLS filed a housing discrimination complaint and successfully defended Juana and Rosa in the Unlawful Detainer action. Now, due to the efforts of SCLS on their behalf, Juana and Rosa are living peacefully in their home with their caregiver.

SCLS needs your help to provide legal assistance to other seniors like Juana and Rosa. SCLS helps poor seniors obtain essential health care services, retain decent housing, and obtain the retirement or disability income they need to live a decent life. With the current political climate, the need is greater than ever. The Golf Tournament is SCLS' major fundraiser for the year. The Golf Tournament 2017 Committee hopes you will help SCLS, protect our communities by becoming a Major Sponsor.

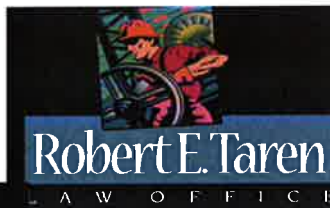
